## Regular -er verbs

Add the following endings to the stem of the verb:
-e $\quad$ Je regarde $=I$ watch/I am watching
-es Tu regardes = You watch/You are watching
-e $\quad$ Il/Elle regarde $=$ He/She watches/is watching
-ons $\quad$ Nous regardons $=$ We watch/We are watching
-ez Vous regardez = You watch/You are watching
-ent Ils/Elles regardent $=$ They watch/They are watching

## Regular -ir verbs

Add the following endings to the stem of the verb:
Example: verb choisir $=$ to choose
-is $\quad$ Je choisis $=$ I choose/I am choosing
-is $\quad$ Tu choisis $=$ You choose/You are choosing
-it II/Elle choisit $=$ He/She chooses/is choosing
-issons $\quad$ Nous choisissons $=$ We choose/We are choosing
-issez $\quad$ Vous choisissez $=$ You choose/You are choosing
-issent Ils/Elles choisissent $=$ They choose/They are choosing

## Regular -re verbs

Add the following endings to the stem of the verb:
Example: verb vendre $=$ to sell
-s Je vends $=$ I sell/I am selling
-s $\quad$ Tu vends $=$ You sell/You are selling

- Il/Elle vend $=$ He/She sells/is selling
-ons $\quad$ Nous vendons $=$ We sell/We are selling
-ez $\quad$ Vous vendez $=$ You sell/You are selling
-ent Ils/Elles vendent $=$ They sell/They are selling

Many common verbs are irregular in the present tense and should be learned off by heart.

## Examples: verb aller = to go

Je vais $=I$ go/I am going
Tu vas $=$ You go/You are going
Il/Elle va $=$ He/She goes/is going
Nous allons $=$ We go/We are going
Vous allez $=$ You go/You are going
Ils/Elles vont = They go/They are
going
